

## Embed a Flash Video in bSpace

This document demonstrates how to embed a Flash Video created by Haas Media Services within a HTML document and save it in a site's **Resources**.


### Steps for Embedding a Flash Video into bSpace

Flash videos embedded in bSpace should be contained within an <object> tag and not within a <script> tag. To assist with this you can use a template designed by Haas to generate the code.

1. Get the name and path of the video you want to put on your site. Media Services generally provides these in the form of a name and location, they will look something like this:

Location: rtmpe://video.haas.berkeley.edu:1935/groups/\_definst\_/mygroup  
Name: videoName.mp4

2. Go to the **Video Template Wizard** by entering the following address in your web browser.  
<https://videos.haas.berkeley.edu/wizard/>
3. The first step in the **Video Template Wizard** is to select the appropriate template. For bSpace there are two templates, one of normal/regular aspect ratio of 3:4, and another for the wide-screen aspect ratio of 16:9. Select one of these.
4. Enter the video file name provided by Media Services in **Step 2** of the **Wizard** and the location, also provided by Media Services, in **Step 3**. **Steps 4** and **5** are not currently used by the bSpace templates. The **Wizard** should look similar to the example below.

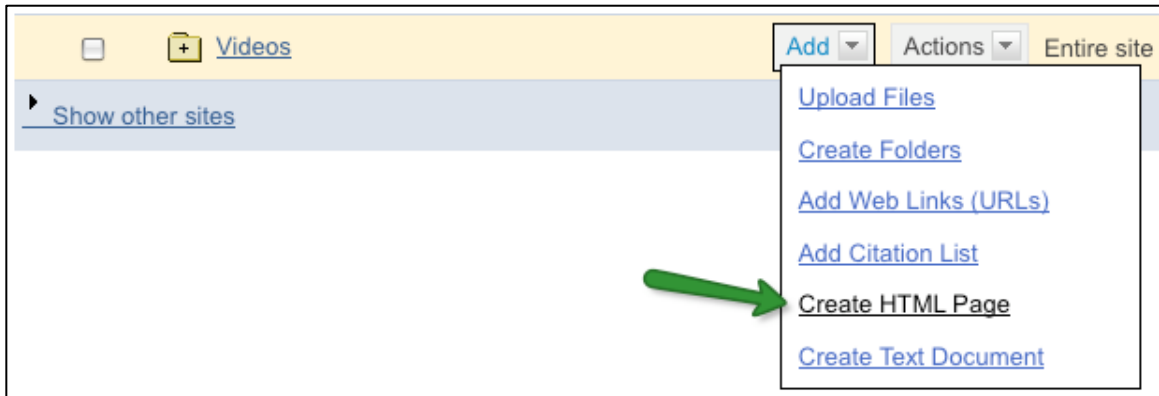

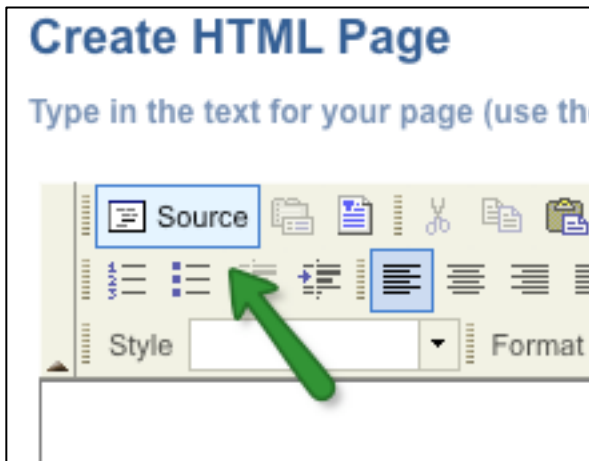
- Step 1: select a template: bSpace Embedded, normal, 3x4
- Step 2: enter the name of the video file: encoder\_mp4\_2.mp4
- Step 3: enter the location of the video file: rtmpe://video.haas.berkeley.edu:1935/secure/\_definst\_/examples
- Step 4: enter your unit name (will also serve as title of the web page): N/A
- Step 5: enter a 1-2 sentence description for your video: N/A

At the bottom of the form is a button labeled "Last Step: Process".

5. Finally, click the **Last Step: Process** button on the **Wizard**. Your **HTML Embed** code will be generated in the box below the button.
6. Copy the entire text from the box where the **Embed** code is generated.
7. Return to your bSpace site.
8. Click **Resources** in the left toolbar.
9. Click the **Add** dropdown found on the same line and to the right of the folder of your choice.
10. From the **Add** dropdown choose **Create HTML Page** to create a new web page.



11. Click the **Source** button in the text editor



12. Paste the **Embed** code from the **Video Template Wizard** into the text field and click **Continue**.
13. Enter the title in the **Name** field and a description of the document. It is recommended that you make the document's name as descriptive as possible. Description does not appear on the main **Resources** page, and thus will not be seen by members of your bSpace site unless they click the additional **Properties** link next to the document.
14. Choose the content's copyright status from the dropdown in the Copyright Status field.
15. Click **Finish** to save your changes.
