

How do I Login to bSpace and Gain Temporary Access to bSpace Course Sites?

bSpace is the course management system at UC Berkeley. Haas first began using it in Spring 2009. Instructors use the site to post non-copyrighted materials for classes (e.g. syllabus, problem sets, etc.). However, keep in mind that not all instructors use bSpace to post materials. You will usually find out how the instructor will use the site during the first class session.

Logging In to bSpace

To login to bSpace go to <https://bspace.berkeley.edu/> and log in with the following information:

- Login ID: **Enter CalNet ID** (the same login BearFacts or AirBears Wifi)
- Password: **Enter Your CalNet ID password/passphrase**

Gaining Temporary Access to bSpace Course Sites

bSpace is designed to allow instructors and GSI's the ability to manage their own student access. Faculty using bSpace "associate" course rosters to their Bspace sites. When you login to bSpace you will see course sites which you are officially "associated" or enrolled in. If you are not officially enrolled in a Haas course and would like to add it in order to keep up with course communications and see course assignments, **please contact your course GSI or instructor**. They will add you to their bSpace course site and you will then see the course listed under your bSpace account.

bSpace and Your Official Email Address

bSpace is used to send course e-mails by instructors and GSI's. The E-mail address used for bSpace is your official UC Berkeley E-mail address. This address should be your @mba.berkeley.edu address. You should verify this address by checking your campus listing on the UCB Calnet directory at <http://calnet.berkeley.edu>. On the left scroll down to the link for "**Directory Update**" under the "**Calnet Directory Services**" menu section. Ensure your @mba address is listed.
